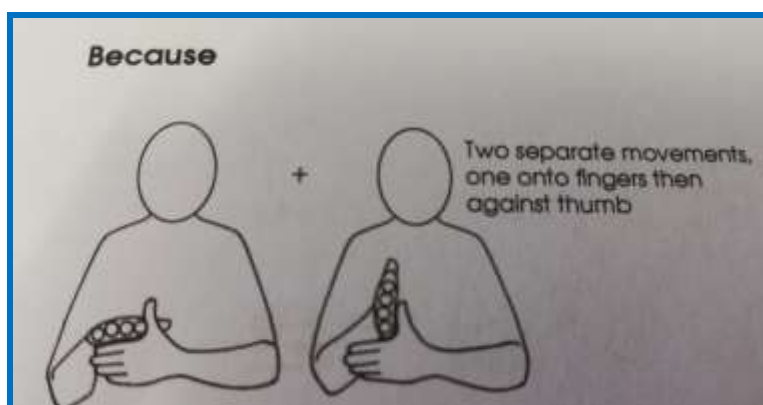
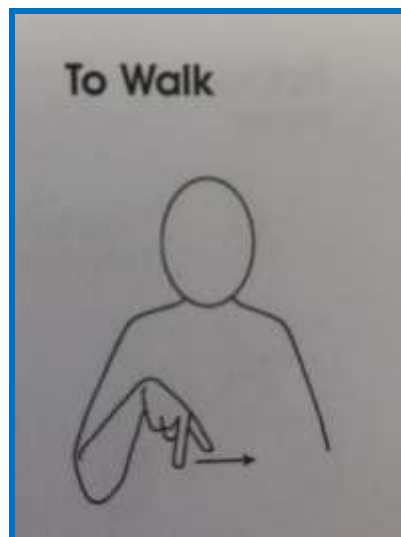
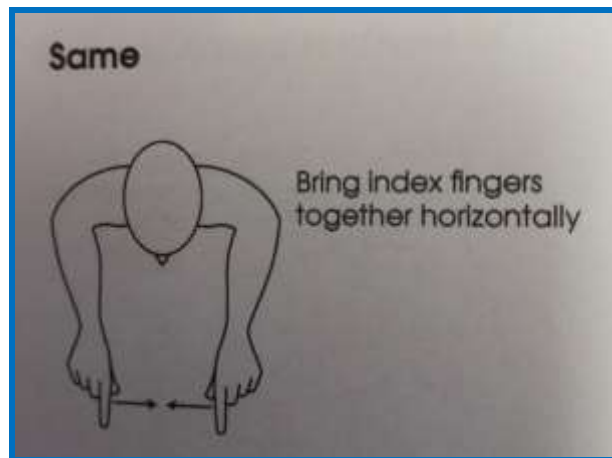
LUNCH MENU
