

Parayhouse Lateral Flow Test Procedure

M/T students will be tested on Monday

Th/F students will be tested on Thursday

4 day per week students will be tested on Monday

All students will be tested each week in the 'Hub'.

Parental permission for weekly tests will be sought prior to school attendance. If parents do not consent, students may still attend school.

In the event of a positive result

The student in question will be isolated and MUST be collected by parents immediately (LA transport will not be able to collect the student and they will also need to self-isolate) and return home to self-isolate for 10 days.

Other close contact students and staff must return home and self-isolate for 10 days. Students should be collected as soon as possible. LA transport will not be permitted to transport the students. They should book a PCR test if they become symptomatic during this time.

If a student (of any age) presents as symptomatic on site

Student should be collected immediately and not return to school until a PCR test has been completed and results received

If the subsequent PCR test is positive, the school will inform all close contacts who should self-isolate for 10 days.

If a student or staff member presents as symptomatic at home, receives a positive PCR result, lives with someone who is confirmed positive or is contact by track and trace regarding contact outside of school, they must self-isolate and/or book a test appointment in line with Government advice.

We ask that parents/staf inform the school of any symptoms and/or positive results as soon as possible in order to protect the whole school community.
